Flower gardeners can't go wrong with the old-fashioned annual cornflower (one of my favourites) which resemble miniature carnations and are easy to grow. It can reseed rampantly if not kept in check. Nevertheless, every gardener should have at least one "can't-fail plant" in their garden, and the lightly <u>fragrant</u> cornflower is perfect for beginners. Cornflower's have delicate papery discs. Dense bright blue




blooms last from spring through midsummer. This species also boasts several varieties offering pink, white, and crimson flowers.
