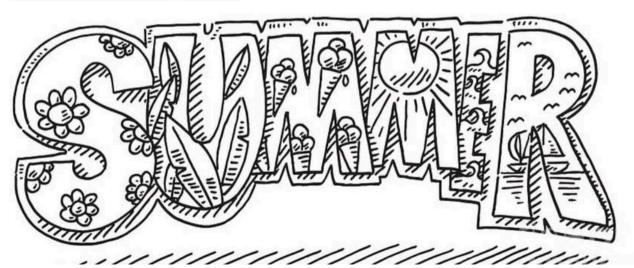

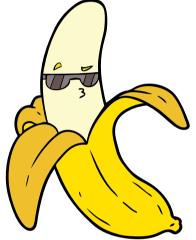

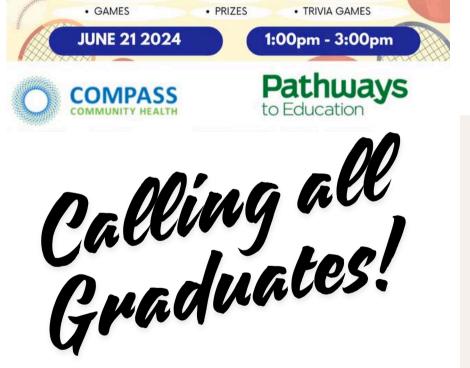

### Pathways Press Exam TIPS

#### Don't cram!

Start studying and reviewing ahead of time. Your brain is a funnel so it takes time and multiple sessions to retain material



Go into the exam confident and positive!

The change in attitude can influence your performance!

#### Active recall is a great study strategy

Instead of studying by highlighting your notes, try this: 1.Quiz yourself on the information

- 2. After you've reviewed, make summaries of the information without looking
- 3. Explain the material to someone who isn't familiar with the topic, such as family and friends. If you are able to explain the concepts to them, you can explain it on your test!
- 4. For memorization, developing tricks like acronyms will help you remember things better!

#### Taking the Exam

Before starting the exam, go through and identify all the questions that you can easily do.

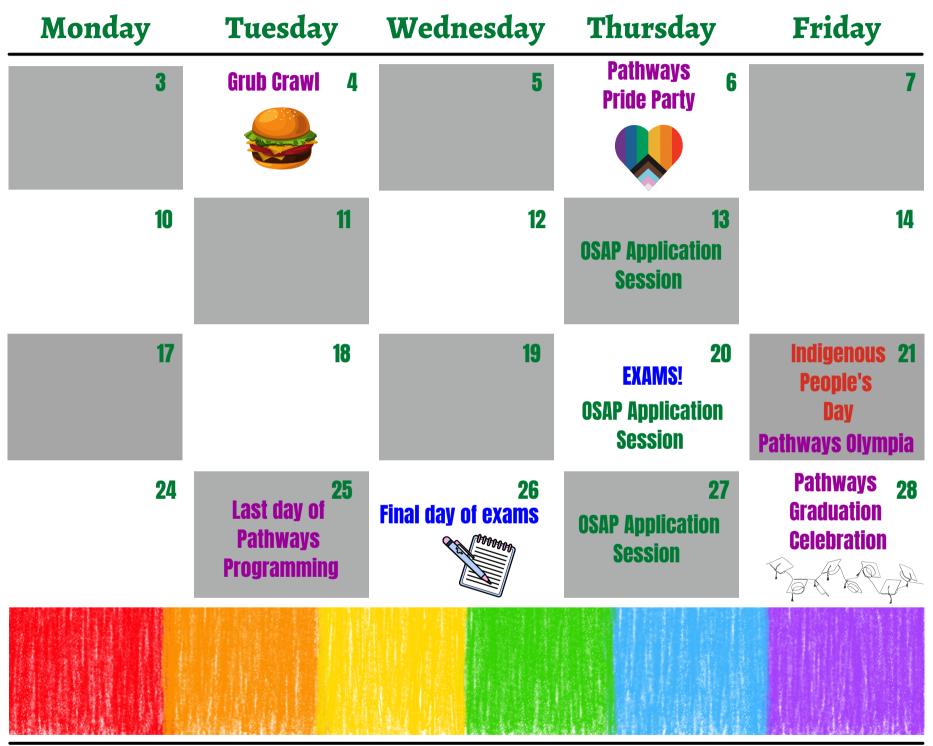
Do these questions first so you don't spend so much time on the questions that you may get stuck on. If you get stuck on a question, move on and come back to it at the end
